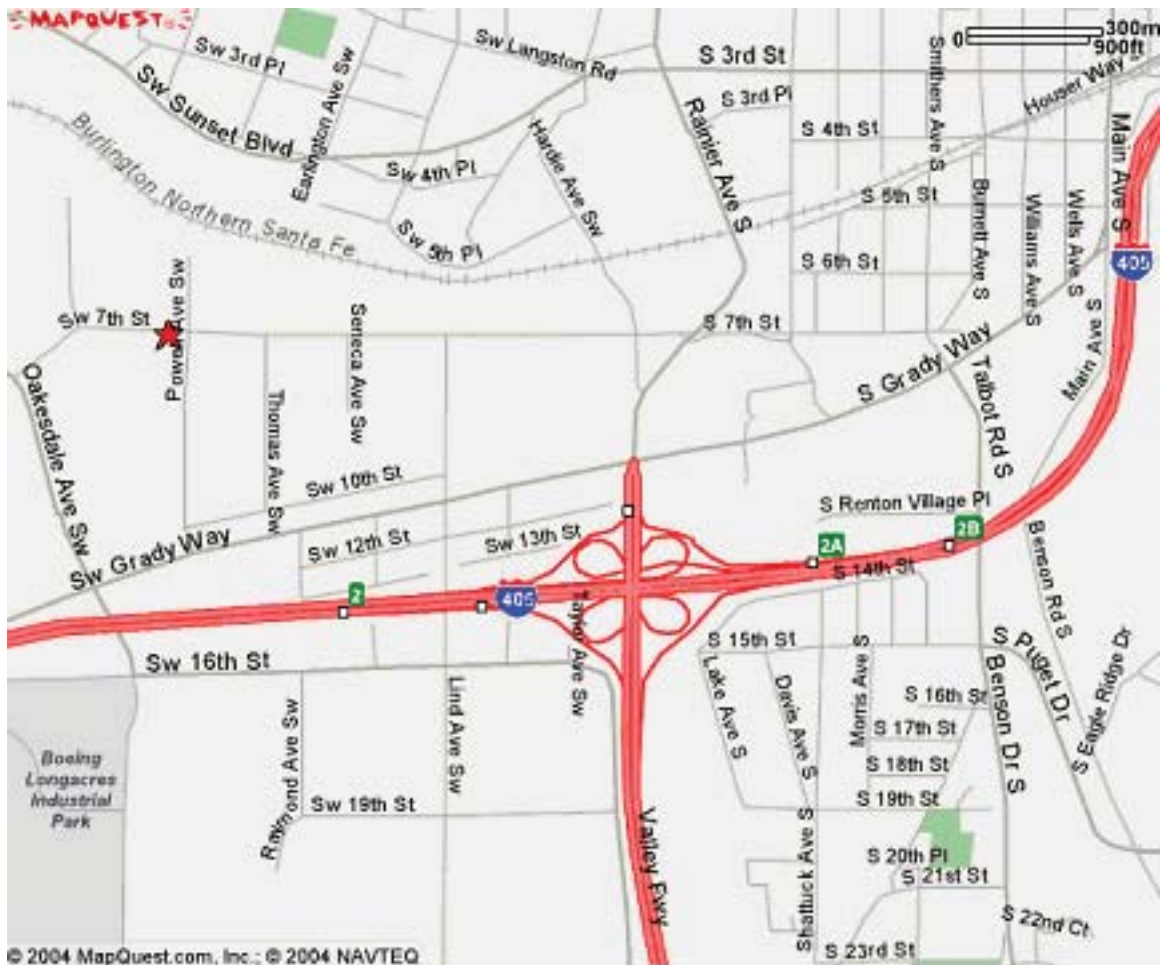

Directions to Enterprise Fleet Management 1119 SW 7th, Renton:

From 167:

Head north into Renton

Stay on 167 as it turns into Rainier Ave S

Turn left on SW 7th (look for the Arby's)

You will pass through 2 stoplights

Enterprise will be approximately 4 blocks after the last stop light on the left hand side

Take I-5 or I-405 south

Take I-405 east to exit 2

Take Rainier Ave S north to SW 7th

Turn left on SW 7th (look for the Arby's)
