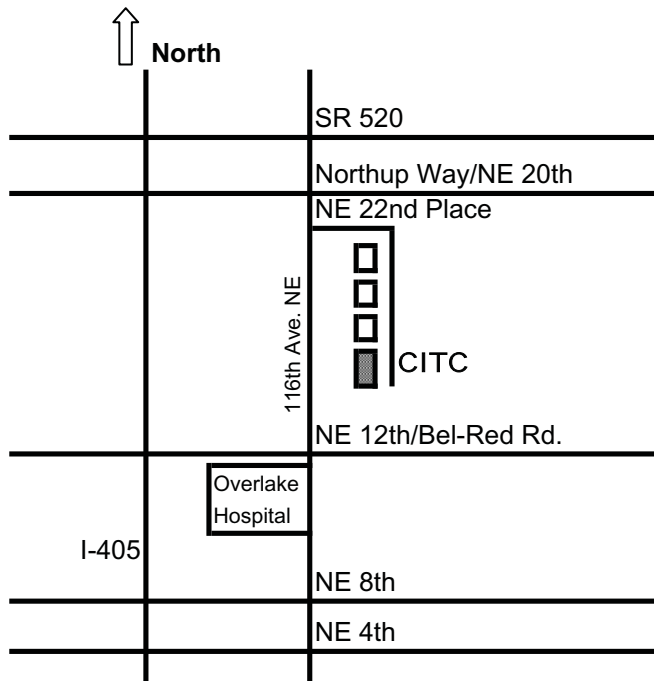

# DIRECTIONS TO CITC

## *Construction Industry Training Council*

**CITC is in a small industrial park** on the east side of 116th, just south of Northup and SR 520.

CITC does not face onto 116th, but is on the lower railroad track level.

**Rooms 1-6** are on the the uphill side of the building in Suite 201. **Room 7** is on the lower railroad level.

**Going East on SR 520:** Take 124th exit. Turn right at light at bottom of ramp. Go to 116th, turn left. Go 1 block to 22nd Place, turn left. Go to end of driveway by railroad tracks and turn right. Go to building with 1930 panted on it.

**Going West on SR 520:** Take 108th exit. Turn right at bottom of ramp, stay in right lane. Turn right on Northup. Go to light at 116th, turn right. Go one block, turn left on 22nd Place. Go to end of driveway by railroad tracks and trun right. Go to building with 1930 painted on it.

**Going South on I-405:** Take the NE 8th East exit. Get into left turn lane and turn left on 116th Ave. NE. Go north to 22nd Place. Turn right on 22nd Place. Go to end of driveway by railroad tracks and turn right. Go to building with 1930 painted on it.

**Going North on I-405:** Take the NE 4th St exit, turn right at top of ramp. Get into left turn lane. Turn left on 116th Ave. NE. Go north to 22nd Place. Turn right on 22nd Place. Go to end of driveway by railroad tracks and turn right. Go to building with 1930 painted on it.
