



The ABC Golf Extravaganza Rules & Instructions Oakbrook Golf Club, Lakewood – July 12, 2018

SCHEDULE

- 10:00 am – 11:00 am **Registration, Lunch and Driving Range Open**
- Register at the tables outside the pro shop on the covered patio
 - Pick up your boxed lunch compliments of *The Blue Book of Building & Construction*
 - 2 drink tickets per person compliments of *Oles Morrison Rinker & Baker* and *Tradesmen International*
 - *19th hole beer tickets good during lunch & dinner (while supplies last) compliments of Trades Labor Corporation*
 - Driving Range is open to all players, compliments of *SeaTac Electric*
- 11:00 am **Proceed to Carts**, player carts compliments of *CHG Building Systems, Inc.* Course marshals will lead you out to your tees at 11:15.
- 11:30 am **Shotgun start** (start at 11:30 after you get out to your hole)
The Grassroots Jr. Golf Foundation Putting Challenge – Stop at the Putting Green in between 18 & 1 to help support the kids, *courtesy of Aspire Consulting, LLC.*
- (approximate) 6:00 pm **Dinner/Awards:** turn in your scorecard as you come in to the dining room for dinner.

EVENT RULES

Scramble Basics (applies to both flights): After each member of your group has teed off from his/her respective tee, the team must choose one shot out of the group. All players will hit their next shot from within one club length of that spot (*but no closer to the hole, and in the same cut of grass as the selected shot, i.e., can't use club length to move from the rough to the fairway*). This continues until your team has holed out or completed their first putts. There is a 2-putt maximum. After the team has completed their first putts, if they do not hole out on the first putt; pick up and record 2 putts. On the green, all players putt from the exact same spot (club length rule doesn't apply). Record one score for the team.

FUN FLIGHT RULES

Scramble Format:

- **Static Tees:** Men play from GREEN; Women play from GOLD.
- **Contest Holes:** All players with Super Tickets will play from where the tee markers are lined up.
- **Super Ticket (\$50 online/\$60 day of):** Each *player* will be allowed to purchase a Super Ticket containing entries for the contest holes before the shotgun start.
- **Mulligans:** mulligans will be sold for \$5 each or \$20 for 5. They may be used for a "do over." May not be used on a contest hole.
- **6" "Call it Good" Putt Ruler** may be used anywhere on the greens to improve the result of a shot by the length of one ruler without counting an extra stroke. Each player may only use their ruler once per hole. *Rulers may not be connected together to advance the ball greater than 6 inches.*
- **Other Restrictions:** Mulligans and the putt ruler cannot be used to win prizes on any special prize hole.

COMPETITIVE FLIGHT RULES

Scramble Format:

- Men play from the WHITE tees.
- Women play from the GOLD tees.
- Drives:** must use each player's drive at least three times during course of the round.
- **Super Ticket (\$50 online/\$60 day of):** Each *player* will be allowed to purchase a Super Ticket containing entries for contest holes before the shotgun start. **NO mulligans or rulers allowed.**
- **Contest Holes:** All players with Super Tickets will play from where the tee markers are lined up.
- Competitive Teams are allowed to participate in the Buy-A-Drive on Hole #18 and the Hit the Green contest on #13.
